

Finding anthropological meaning in the moments in-between the meaningful

In-between: Exploring small cracks of everyday life attends to overlooked moments in everyday life, events and encounters that do not fit easily into anthropological categories or more generalizing accounts. This focus allows the authors to dwell on things such as a playground sandbox, the fist of an infant in its mother's mouth, or a house layered with generations of family memories. In focusing on discrete moments and encounters, the chapters draw out the texture and qualities of sensory entanglements with matter, whether a grain of sand, a pencil, or the city. With a phenomenological approach to ethnography and autoethnography, the volume contributes theoretically and methodologically to an anthropology of affect and materiality.
